My scaly skin protects me.






I am said to be very dangerous

that I use to defend myself.






I depend on the cover of the deep forest for food and shelter.

I have several white stripes and spots on my tan fur to help me blend in.






My arms are longer than my legs,

I am an excellent decomposer.






I use my large ears to cool

animals travel through the forest.






I am an excellent climber.

decomposers.






I feed on a variety of leaves,

I am one of the smallest antelope.






I spend most of my day
